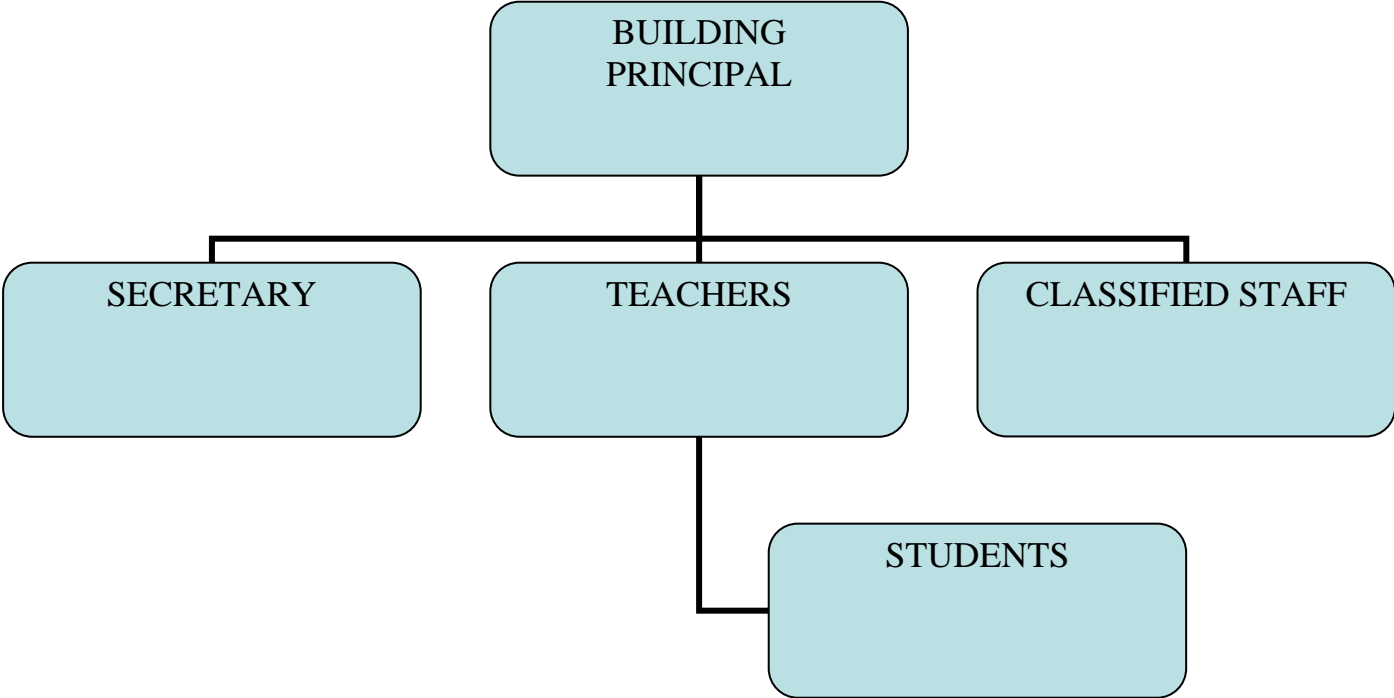


MORROW ELEMENTARY SCHOOL OVERVIEW

The Little Miami Local Schools Morrow Elementary was built in 1913. It has served many members of the community during its life. We currently are home to 530 Pre-k – 4th graders. Morrow Elementary is a Title 1 building utilizing two full time Intervention Specialists. Morrow Elementary has 54 staff members on board including all Educational Aides. MISSION STATEMENT

Our mission is to make Morrow Elementary an effective school where children will feel 100% successful on a daily basis in an environment that will allow children to learn and teachers to teach.

GOALS

- Expand gifted services in grades k-4.
- Continue to provide support to ensure the K-6 Houghton Mifflin reading program is used in an effective manner, creating an “integrity checklist.”
- Address achievement gaps in the area of reading and math with economically disadvantaged and special education students by diagnosing learner needs and defining appropriate research based strategies for high levels of achievement using OAT/Value-Added data.
- Provide continued support for special needs students so they can be included in age-appropriate classrooms; identify appropriate modifications for implementation of grade-level standards (use Dibels K-2) following the OISM recommended processes.
- Examine core programs and create checklists to insure an 80% passage goal.
