

## TUBERCULIN TEST

The Ohio Public Health Council revised Section 4701 – 15 – 02 which requires that all personnel new to the school system, (certified, classified, bus drivers, etc.) must present documented evidence of having a negative tuberculin test as defined by the “American Thoracic Society”. The Mantoux Test 5 TU PPD must be administered within 90 days of their first day of work.

Personnel may have their family doctor administer and certify the results or the Warren County Health Department in Lebanon provides the service. The Health Department will give the test Monday, Tuesday, and Friday 7:30 a.m. – 12:00 noon and 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. The Warren County Health Department will charge a fee of \$8.00 to administer the test.
